WISCONSIN INCOME TAX CREDITS

No WI tax liability—Economic Development Tax Credits may be transferred to a business providing non-cash consideration in connection with the eligible activity.

In addition to lower tax rates, Wisconsin is a single-sales factor state, and has a 30% exclusion for long-term capital gains.
